

## Stitch of the Week

Pattern \#232

## Rosebud / Tulip Stitch Pattern

To follow along with this stitch pattern go to Creative Grandma youtube channel.

Note: When working any stitch pattern use recommended hook size from the yarn label you are using for best results.

Stitches: Chain (ch). Slip st (sl st). Single crochet (sc). Half Double crochet (hdc). Two Half Double crochet cluster: make 2 half complete half double crochets into the st or sp indicated, leaving the last loop of each stitch on the hook, yarn over and draw a loop through all loops on hook. Three Half Double Crochet Cluster: make 3 half complete half double crochets into the st or sp indicated, leaving the last loop of each stitch on the hook, yarn over and draw a loop through all loops on the hook.
Double crochet (dc).

## Rosebud / Tulip Stitch Pattern

Stitch Pattern is a multiple of $\mathbf{4 + 2}$.
For working a sample swatch, using the background color, ch 30.

Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. End of Row 4, fasten off.

Row 5: Join color of your choice (for leaves) in beg sc, ( 2 hdc cluster, ch 2, 2 hdc cluster) in beg sc, * ch 1 , skip next 3 sc, ( 2 hdc cluster, ch 1,2 hdc cluster) in next sc *, rep from * to * across. Fasten off.

Row 6: Return to beg of Row 5, join color of your choice (for flower) in ch- 2 sp of beg cluster shell, 3 hdc cluster in ch- 2 sp of beg shell, * ch 3 , skip next ch- $1 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ hdc cluster in ch-2 sp of next cluster shell *, rep from * to * across. Fasten off.

Row 7: Return to beg of Row 6. Join background color in top of beg cluster, ch 1 , sc in top right-hand side of beg cluster, *2 dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ sc of skipped 3 sc 3 rows below (Row 4) pulling dc up to current level of work, 2 sc in top right-hand side of next cluster *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 8-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. End of Row 10, Fasten off.

Rep Rows 5-10 for pattern.
