Stitch of the Week

Pattern # 246

The Millennium Stitch

NOTE: Instructions for the Millennium Throw as shown in photo is available by going to www.redheart.com and search for pattern number LW2015 The Millennium Throw.

This Stitch Pattern is a multiple of 2 plus 4. Use recommended hook size listed on yarn label you are using.

These instructions are written for using two different colors, Color A and Color B, to use one color, do not fasten off at end of rows indicated continue working in stitch pattern.

To make a sample swatch, using color A, ch 24.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (23 sc made).

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in back loop of first 3 sc, ch 3, slip st in top front loop of last sc made, * sc in back loop of next 2 sc, ch 3, slip st in top front loop of last sc made *, repeat from * to * across to within last 2 sc across, sc in back loop of each of last 2 sc, turn. Fasten off.

Row 3: With color B, join in back loop of first sc 2 rows below, ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across, turn.

Rows 4 and 5: Working in both loops, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Repeat Rows 3-6 for pattern, when working in more than one color, change colors at the end of Row 6.
