Stitch of the Week

**Pattern # 247** 

The Stacked V Stitch Bobble Stitch

This Stitch Pattern is a multiple of 3.

Use recommended hook size listed on yarn label you are using.

NOTE: When starting a new row, when working in one color only, turn your work and sl st in ch-2 sp of first v st of next row.

When working with 2 or more colors, fasten off at the end of each row and return to the beg of previous row and join new color with sl st in ch-2 sp of first V st of previous row.

## **SPECIAL STITCHES:**

**Bobble Stitch (Bobble st):** work 2 dc in st indicated leaving the last lp of each st on hook, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

To make a sample swatch, ch 36.

**Row 1:** (Dc, ch 2, bobble st) in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, \* skip next 2 ch, (bobble st, ch 2, bobble st) in next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across.

NOTE: When working in one color only, turn your work and sl st in ch-2 sp of first v st of next row.

When working with 2 or more colors, fasten off at the end of each row and return to the beg of previous row and join new color with sl st in ch-2 sp of first V st of previous row.

Row 2: Ch 2, (dc, ch 2, bobble st) in ch-2 sp of first V st, (bobble st, ch 2, bobble st) in ch-2 sp of each V st across.

NOTE: When working in one color only, turn your work and sl st in ch-2 sp of first v st of next row.

When working with 2 or more colors, fasten off at the end of each row and return to the beg of previous row and join new color with sl st in ch-2 sp of first V st of previous row.

REPEAT ROW 2 FOR PATTERN.
