### Stitch of the Week

#### Pattern # 92

### Wave Length Stitch

For best results use recommended hook size listed on yarn label you are using.

This stitch pattern has a multiple of 14 plus 2.

**Note:** This pattern is written for a three color combination, you can use as many colors as you like by changing colors in Rows 2 and Row 4 of pattern.

To Make a Sample Swatch, ch 30.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Fasten off, turn. (29 sc)

**Row 2:** Join Color B in first sc, ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, \* hdc in each of next 2 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, tr in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts \*, rep from \* to \* across to within last 13 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, tr in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of last 2 sts. Fasten off, turn.

**Row 3:** Join Color A in first sc, ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off, turn.

**Row 4:** Join Color C in first sc, ch 3 (counts as first tr), tr in next st, \* dc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, tr in each of next 3 sts \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 13 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, dc in each of next 2 sts, tr in each of last 2 sts. Fasten off, turn.

**Row 5:** Join Color A in first tr, ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off, turn.

**Repeat Rows 2 – 5 for pattern.**
