Little Bundle Baby Afghan

Pattern # HOB1

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: 42 x 42 inches

Materials Needed:

Yarn Art “Dancing Baby” (3) Light weight yarn, (100 g/ 250 m/ 273 yds/ 3.5 ozs) each skein:

8 skeins # 822

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm) or size to obtain gauge.

Gauge: Working in Bean Stitch pattern; 7 bean stitches and 12 rows = 4 inches.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Stitches: Chain (ch). Slip st (sl st).

Bean Stitch: insert hook in stitch or sp indicated, yo, pull through st or sp, pull up on hook to make your lp longer, [yo, insert hook into same st or sp, yo, pull through st or sp, pull up on hook to make your lp longer] twice, yo, pull through all 6 lps on hook, ch 1 to secure.

Baby Afghan

Ch 131.

Row 1: Insert hook in 3rd ch from hook, yo, pull through ch, pull up on hook to make your lp longer, [yo, insert hook into same ch, yo, pull through ch, pull up on hook to make your lp longer] twice, yo, pull through all 6 lps on hook, ch 1 to secure (bean stitch made), * skip next ch, insert hook into next ch, yo, pull through ch, pull up on hook to make your lp longer, [yo, insert hook into same ch, yo, pull through ch, pull up on hook to make your lp longer] twice, yo, pull through all 6 lps on hook, ch 1 to secure (bean stitch made) *, rep from * to * across, ch 2, turn.

Little Bundle Baby Afghan Page 2.

Row 2: Working on left side of beg bean st, * insert hook in the left side of bean st in sp that looks like a small triangle, pull work slightly to the left to see the triangle sp, insert hook in triangle sp, yo, pull through sp, pull up on hook to make your lp longer, [yo, insert hook into same sp, yo, pull through sp, pull up on hook to make your lp longer] twice, yo, pull through all 6 lps on hook, ch 1 to secure (bean stitch made) *, rep from * to * in each bean st across to within last bean st, skip last bean st, work bean st in space between last bean st and ending ch 2, ch 2, turn.

Rows 3-118: Repeat Row 2 for pattern. End of Row 118, turn and start afghan border.

Afghan Border

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in space on left side of first bean st, *work 2 dc in space on left side of each bean st across to next corner *, ch 2 (corner made), working down length, work 3 dc in same sp as last dc made, skip next row-end st, 2 dc in next row-end st, ** skip next row-end st, 3 dc in next row-end st, skip next row-end st, 2 dc in next row-end st **, rep from ** to ** across to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), 2 dc in same sp as last dc made, working across bottom of foundation ch, rep from * to * across to within last bean st, work 2 dc in last ch across at bottom of last bean st, ch 2 (corner made), work 2 dc in same sp as last dc made, skip next row-end st, 3 dc in next row-end st, *** skip next row-end st, 2 dc in next row-end st, skip next row-end st, 3 dc in next row-end st ***, rep from *** to *** down length to within last row, 2 dc in same sp as beg ch 3, ch 2, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), fpdc in next dc, [* dc in next dc, fpdc in next dc *, rep from * to * across to next corner ch-2 sp, 4 hdc in corner ch-2 sp] 4 times around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.
