



Creative Grandma

Quick and Easy Crochet Rose

Pattern # CF-2

Materials Needed:

Approx. 8-10 yards (4) medium weight yarn per flower.

Yarn needle.

**Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm) or
For best results use recommended hook size listed on yarn label you are using.**

Finished Size: 2 ¾ inches in diameter.

ROSE

Ch 28

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch] across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 4 hdc in next ch-1 sp, sl st in next sc, 5 hdc in next ch-1 sp, [sl st in next sc, 5 dc in next ch-1 sp] 5 times, [sl st in next sc, 5 tr in next ch-1 sp] 6 times, sl st in last sc. Fasten off, leaving a sewing length.

ASSEMBLY

Return to beg of Row 2, with right side facing, fold right side of first petal on top of right side of 2nd petal, turn work upside down and wrap bottom of foundation row around bottom of petals working around to end of Row forming the Rose, sew Rose together sewing through all layers from the outside through each layer to the center, repeat around base of Rose is secure. Leave your sewing length to use for attaching to your project, then trim and weave in ends.
