



Stitch of the Week

Pattern #211

Trinity Stitch Pattern

Note: When working any stitch pattern use recommended hook size from the yarn label you are using for best results.

Make a chain with a multiple of 2.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc3tog as follows, insert hook first into same ch as sc just made, yo, pull through st (2 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch, yo, pull through st (3 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch, yo, pull through st (4 lps on hook), yo, pull through 4 lps on hook, * ch 1, sc3tog as follows, insert hook first into same ch as 3rd leg of cluster just made, yo, pull through st, (2 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch, yo, pull through st (3 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch, yo, pull through st (4 lps on hook), yo, pull through 4 lps on hook *, rep from * to * across, sc in last ch across in same ch as ending cluster, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in beg sc, sc3tog as follows, inserting hook first into same sp as beg sc just made, yo, pull through st (2 lps on hook), then insert hook into top of next cluster st, yo, pull through st (3 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch-1 sp, yo, pull through sp (4 lps on hook), yo, pull through 4 lps on hook, * ch 1, sc3tog as follows, insert hook first into same ch-1 sp as last cluster made, yo, pull through st (2 lps on hook), then insert hook into top of next cluster st, yo, pull through st (3 lps on hook), then insert hook into next ch-1 sp, yo, pull through sp, (4 lps on hook), yo, pull through 4 lps on hook *, rep from * to * across, sc in same ending sc as last cluster made, turn.

Repeat Row 2 for Pattern.
