

Stitch of the Week Pattern #214

Interlocking Shell Stitch Pattern

Note: When working any stitch pattern use recommended hook size from the yarn label you are using for best results.

Make a chain with a multiple of 6 + 4. Example $6 \ge 3 = 18 + 4 = 22$, $6 \ge 10 = 60 + 4 = 64$, etc.

NOTE: To work a sample swatch, ch 28.

Row 1: (Right side): 2 dc in 4th ch from hook, (beg ch 3 counts as first dc), skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch, * skip next 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch *, rep from * to * across to last 3 ch, skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in last ch, turn. **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, * ch 2, dc5tog over next 5 sts, ch 2, sc in next st *, rep from * to * across, ending last rep in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), 2 dc in same beg st, skip next 2 ch, sc in top of next cluster, * skip next 2 ch, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 ch, sc in top of next cluster *, rep from * to * across to last cluster, skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in last sc, turn.

REPEAT ROWS 2 and 3 FOR PATTERN.
