



Stitch of the Week

Pattern #206

Two Stitch Chevron Ripple Stitch Pattern

Make a chain with a multiple of 15 + 1.

NOTE: A foundation chain of at least 31 is necessary to work a sample swatch.

Row 1: (Right side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in each of next 5 ch, * (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in each of next 6 ch, skip next 2 ch, dc in each of next 6 ch *, rep from * to * across to last 8 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in each of next 5 ch, (dc2tog) in last 2 ch, [to work dc2tog: (yo, draw up lp in next st, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) twice; yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook- dc2tog made]. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Skip first st, sc in each of next 6 dc, * (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 6 dc, skip next 2 dc, sc in each of next 6 dc *, rep from * to * across to last ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 5 dc, (sc2tog) in last 2 dc [to work

sc2tog: (yo, draw up lp in next st) twice; yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook – sc2tog-made], ch 3, turn. Leaving beg turning 2 chs unworked.

Row 3: Skip first st, dc in each of next 6 sc, *(dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 6 sc, skip next 2 sc, dc in each of next 6 sc *, rep from * to * across to last ch-2 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-2 sp, dc in each of next 5 sc, (dc2tog) in last 2 sc, ch 1, turn. Leaving beg turning 1 ch unworked.

Repeat Rows 2 & 3 for pattern.
