

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (first dc), skip next dc, (dc in next dc, ch 1) twice, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, \* cluster working over next (dc, cluster, dc sts), ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1 \*, rep from \* to \* across to within last 3 dc, dc in next dc, skip next dc, dc in top of ch 3, turn.

**Repeat Row 2 for pattern.** 

## Stitch of the Week Pattern #208

## Lacey Shell Ripple Stitch Pattern

## Note: When working any stitch pattern use recommended hook size from the yarn label you are using for best results.

Make a chain with a multiple of 11 + 14

## **NOTE:** A foundation chain of at least 36 is necessary to work a sample swatch.

**Row 1:** (Right side): Dc in  $4^{th}$  ch from hook, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, 3 dc in next ch, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, \*(yo, draw up a lp in next ch, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times, yo, draw through all 4 lps on hook – cluster made, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, 3 dc in next ch, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across to within last 2 ch, dc in each of next 2 ch, turn.
