Stitch of the Week

Pattern # 251

The Double Cross Lace Stitch

Multiple of 7 plus 4.

This stitch pattern requires a larger hook size then yarn recommended hook size. If using (3) Light weight yarn use a size I -9 US (5.5 mm) hook. If using (4) worsted weight yarn use size J-10 US (6 mm) or size to suit your desired effect.

To work a sample swatch, ch 32.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn.

Row 2 (Right Side): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each of next 2 sts, *skip next 2 sts, tr in each of next 2 sts, working behind 2 tr just made, tr in first skipped st, then tr in next skipped st, dc in each of the next 3 sts, skip next 2 sts, tr in next 2 sts, working in front of 2 tr just made, tr in first skipped st, tr in next skipped st, dc in each of the next 3 sts, tr in next skipped st, dc in each of the next 3 sts, sts *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

Note: Since this pattern ends with a single crochet row, there is no need for a finishing row. End pattern on Row 3.
