Stitch of the Week # 79

**Quick and Easy Shell Stitch** 

Skill Level: Beginner

**Note:** Use hook size recommended on yarn label of the yarn you will be using.

## Pattern has a Stitch Multiple of 6 plus 2.

To make a sample swatch, ch 26.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, \* skip next 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc) 2 dc in same beg st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, \* skip next 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st \*, rep from \* to \* across to within last 3 sts, skip next 2 sts, 3 dc in last st, turn. **Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, skip next 2 dc, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sts, \*sc in next st, skip next 2 sts, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sts \*, rep from \* to \* across to ending turning ch3, sc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

## **Rep Rows 2 & 3 for pattern, ending pattern with Row 3.**

For a straight edge on the last row, complete the Finishing Row below.

## **Finishing Row (Last Row)**

Ch 3 (counts as first dc) dc in same beg st, skip next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, \* hdc in next st, skip next st, 3 dc in next st, skip next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 3 sts, hdc in next st, skip next st, 2 dc in last st. Fasten off, weave in ends.
