## Materials Needed:

Red Heart $\circledR^{\circledR}$ "Super Saver®" (4) med worsted weight yarn.

Yarn needed is listed under each of the choices below.

Crochet Hook: $\mathbf{5 . 5}$ mm [US I-9]. Yarn Needle.

GAUGE: First 3 Rnds $=5 \frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter.. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Note: Start each dc Rnd and each Popcorn Rnd with ch 3 (first dc). Start each $\operatorname{tr}$ Rnd with ch 4 (first tr).

Refer to color needed below photo of the block you are making.

Afghan: Block (make 20): BEGIN: With crochet hook size I-9, ch 5, sl st in first ch to form ring.

Rnd 1: [popcorn st in ring, ch 2] 8 times, join with sl st to top of beg popcorn st. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join new color in any ch-2 sp, (popcorn st, ch 3) twice in each ch-2 sp around, join with sl st to top of beg popcorn st. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join new color in any ch-3 sp, ch 4 (first tr) ( 2 tr , ch 2, 3 tr ) in same beg ch- 3 sp , ch 1 , skip next popcorn st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next popcorn st, * (3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next popcorn st, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next popcorn st *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 4 . Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join White in any sc, * (3 tr, ch 2,3 tr) in sc, skip next ch-1 sp and next $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch-2 sp , ch 1 , skip next tr , sc in next tr, skip next tr and next ch-1 sp, 2 dc in next sc, skip next ch-1 sp and next tr, sc in next tr, ch 1 , skip next tr, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, skip next 3 tr and next ch-1 sp *, rep from * to $*$ around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 4.

Rnd 5: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in each st around, work ( 2 tr , ch 2, 2 tr ) in each corner ch-2 sp, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 .

Rnds 6 \& 7: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in each dc around, work ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each corner ch-2 sp, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 8: Join new color in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp, * ( 2 tr , ch $2,2 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in corner ch-2 sp, (skip next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ dc between skipped 2 dc and next dc) 13 times, skip next $2 \mathrm{dc} *$, rep from $*$ to $*$ around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 4 . Fasten off.

Rnd 9: Join new color in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp, * (4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc ) in corner ch-2 sp, skip next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, (skip next st, 2 dc in next st) 12 times, skip next 2 sts $*$, rep from $*$ to $*$ around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 .

Rnd 10: Join new color in beg dc, ch 3 (first dc), dc in next 3 dc , (dc, ch 2, dc) in corner ch-2 sp, dc in next 4 dc , [tr in corresponding sp between dc and next dc 2 rnds below (Rnd 8) pulling tr up to current level of work, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 13 times, $*$ dc in next 4 dc , (dc, ch 2 , dc) in
corner ch- 2 sp , dc in next 4 dc , [tr in corresponding sp between dc and next dc 2 rnds below (Rnd 8 ) pulling tr up to current level of work, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 13 times $*$, rep from $*$ to $*$ around, join with sl st to beg ch 3.

## Assembly

Using same color as Rnd 10, sew or crochet blocks together 4 across by 5 long, using blps of sts of Rnd 10 matching sts from corner to corner

## Afghan Border

Rnd 1: With right side of afghan facing, join new color in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp , ch 3 (first dc) (dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in same corner ch-2 sp, dc in each st and each ch sp on each side of each joining seam around, work ( 2 dc , ch 2, 2 dc ) in each corner ch-2 sp , join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 .

Rnd 2: Ch 1 , sc in each dc around, work 3 sc in each corner ch- 2 sp , join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join new color in beg sc, [Ch $1, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next sc] around, ending with ch $1, \mathrm{sl}$ st in beg sl st. Fasten off.

4 ounces \# 324 Bright Yellow 7 ounces \# 3934 Day Glow 24 ounces \# 311 White 16 ounces \#3620 Glow Worm 8 ounces \# 672 Spring Green 16 ounces \#368 Paddy Green

Materials Needed:

Stitch Studio "Picnic" (3) Light weight 100\% Acrylic yarn (355 yds/
$325 \mathrm{~m} / 100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5$ ounces) each skein: 4 skeins \# SS3003-06 Lolipop Pink

Crochet Hook Size: I-9 (5.5 mm)

Gauge: Rows 2-5 rep twice $=31 / 2$ inches. 8 V sts $=5$ inches.

## Loving Hug Shawl

With Lolipop Pink, ch 95

Row 1: (Sc, ch 2, sc) in 2nd ch from hook, *skip next 2 ch , (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch*, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 2: Skip beg sc, insert hook into first ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first hdc + ch 1 ), dc in same ch-2 sp, work (dc, ch 1 , dc) in each ch-2 sp across to last ch2 sp , (dc, ch 1, hdc) in last ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 3: Skip beg hdc, DO NOT CHAIN, insert hook into first ch- 1 sp , (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-1 sp across, turn.

Rows 4 \& 5: DO NOT CHAIN, skip beg sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 sp across, turn.

Rows 6-159: Rep Rows 2-5 for pattern, ending pattern with Row 3. End of Row 159, do not fasten off. Row 159 is first side of border, cont to border to work remaining three sides.

## BORDER

Rnd 1: Working down length of shawl, work * (sc, ch 2, sc) in first row-end st, [skip next row, (sc, ch 2, sc) in row-end st of next row] across to within last 3 rows, skip next 2 rows, (sc, ch $2, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in last row-end st *, working across bottom of foundation row, (sc, ch $2, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in base of each sc v st across to next corner, rep from * to * around remaining side, join with sl st to beg sc of Row 159.

Rnd 2: Skip first sc, sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch $1, *$ ( sc, ch 2 sc ) in each ch-2 sp of each sc v st across to next corner, ch $2 *$, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 3: Skip first sc, sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 3 (first dc) dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 3 , sl st in top and side of last dc made, work * 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 3 , sl st in top and side of last dc made *, rep from * to * around, Join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Few Yards Accent color A
$1 / 2 \mathrm{oz}$. Accent color B
1 oz . White
Crochet hook size H-8 US ( 5 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Special Stitches: Bobble Stitch: [yo, insert hook in st or sp indicated, yo, pull through st or sp] twice, yo, pull through all lps on hook. Double Crochet V Stitch: (dcvst): (dc, ch 2, dc) in st or sp indicated. Single Crochet V Stitch: (scvst): (sc, ch 2, sc) in st or sp indicated.

## Granny Square

With Color A, ch 4, join with sl st in $4^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook to form a ring.

Rnd 1: [Bobble in ring, ch 2] 8 times, join with sl st to top of beg bobble. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join Color B in any ch-2 sp, ch 1, work (sc, 3 dc , sc) in each ch-2 sp around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join White in $3^{\text {rd }}$ st of beg petal, ch 1 , ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, sc) in same joining st, (dc, ch 2, dc) between last sc of current petal and first sc of next petal in top of corresponding bobble st 2 rnds below (Rnd 1), * (sc, ch 2, sc) in $3^{\text {rd }}$ st of next petal, (dc, ch 2 , dc) between last sc of current petal and first sc of next petal in top of corresponding bobble st 2 rnds below (Rnd 1) *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Gauge: First 3 rnds $=31 / 2$ inches in diameter.

## Floral Lace Granny Square Page 2.

Rnd 4: Join Color A in ch-2 sp of any dcvst, ch 3 (first dc) (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 sp. Fasten off, skip next dcvst, * Join Color A in ch-2 sp of next dcvst, ch 3 (first dc) (dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same ch- 2 sp, Fasten off, skip next dcvst *, rep from * to * around. (4 Corner shell sts made).

Rnd 5: Join White in any ch-2 sp of any corner shell, ch 3 (first dc) ( 2 dc , ch 2, 3 dc ) in same beg ch- 2 sp of shell, 2 tr in each of the next 3 corresponding ch -2 sps 2 rnds below (Rnd 3), * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp of next corner shell st, 2 tr in each of the next 3 corresponding ch- 2 sps 2 rnds below (Rnd 3) *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 .

Rnd 6: Sl st across to corner ch-2 sp, ch 3
(first dc) (dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in same corner ch-2 sp, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc, skip next $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ between skipped dc and next tr, [skip next 2 tr, 2 dc between skipped trs and next tr] twice, skip next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2$ dc between skipped trs and next dc, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc, skip next dc, * ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next corner ch-2 sp, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc, skip next dc, 2 dc between skipped dc and next tr, [skip next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2$ dc between skipped trs and next tr] twice, skip next 2 tr, 2 dc between skipped trs and next dc, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc, skip next dc *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 7: Join Color B in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (first dc) ( 2 dc , ch 2, 3 dc ) in same corner ch- 2 sp, work 2 dc between each group of 2 dc across to next corner, * ( 3 dc , ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next corner ch- 2 sp , work 2 dc between each group of 2 dc across to next corner *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 . Fasten off.

Materials Needed:
Isaac Mizrahi "Sutton" (6) Super Bulky weight yarn ( $85 \%$ Acrylic, 15\% Wool (4 oz/113 g/ $68 \mathrm{yds} / 62 \mathrm{~m}$ ) per skein:

2 skeins color of your choice
Crochet hook size K-10 1/2 (6.5 mm) or size to obtain gauge.

Gauge: $9 \mathrm{hdc}=4$ inches; First 3 rnds $=4$ inches in diameter.

Special Stitches: Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc): insert hook from front to back, then from back to front around post of stitch indicate, Yo, pull around post of stitch, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice.

## HAT

With yarn and using size $\mathrm{K}-101 / 2(6.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ hook, ch 3.

Rnd 1: Work 9 hdc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook, join with sl st in top of beg ch 2. ( 10 hdc )

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (first hdc) hdc in same beg st, work 2 hdc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 2. ( 20 hdc )

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (first hdc) hdc in same beg st, hdc in next st, * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 2. ( 30 hdc )

Rnd 4: Ch 2 (first hdc) hdc in same beg st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, $* 2$ hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 2 sts *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 2 . (40 hdc)

Rnd 5: Ch 2 (first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2 . (40 hdc)

Rnd 6: Ch 2 (first hdc) hdc in same beg st, hdc in each of next 7 sts, * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2 . (45 hdc)

Rnds 7-9: Ch 2 (first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2 . (45 hdc)

## Crocheted Chunky Hat Page 2.

Rnd 10: Ch 2 (first hdc) hdc in same beg st, hdc in each of next 8 sts, * 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 8 sts *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2 . (50 hdc)

Rnd 11: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 . (50 dc)

Rnd 12-14: Ch 3 (first dc), fpdc in next st, * dc in next st, fpdc in next st *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 . ( 25 dc and 25 Fpdc for a total of 50 sts )

Rnd 15: Ch 2 (first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2. ( 50 hdc ) Fasten off, weave in end.

Pattern \# 607

Skill Level: Beginner
Size: One size fits most.
Measurements: 8 inches wide by $38^{\prime \prime}$ around.

## Materials Needed:

Ice Yarns "Cakes Wool Chunky Colors" (6) Super Bulky Weight Yarn, (30\% Wool/ 70\% Acrylic), ( $200 \mathrm{gr} / 7.05 \mathrm{oz} / 160 \mathrm{~m} / 174 \mathrm{yds}$ ) per ball:

1 ball color of your choice

Crochet Hook Size Q ( 16 mm ) or size to obtain gauge.
Yarn Needle.

Gauge: 5 sts and 5 rnds $=4$ inches.

## COWL

Ch 48, join with sl st to form a ring, making sure you do not twist the chain.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, hdc in each ch around, do not join, mark each rnd. (48 hdc made).

Rnds 2-8: Skip front and back lp of first st, work hdc in the loop below the back loop of same beg st, * skip the front and back loop of next st, work hdc in the loop below the back loop of same st *, rep from * to * around, do not join, make sure to mark the first st of each rnd. (48 hdc made).

Rnd 9: Skip front and back lp of first st, work sc in the loop below the back loop of same beg st, * skip the front and back loop of next st, work sc in the loop below the back loop of same st *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg sc. (48 sc made).

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in top 2 loops of each sc around, join with sl st to top of beg sc. Fasten off, weave in ends on wrong side. (48 sc made).

## Chunky Knit Look Cowl Page 2.

## Bottom Edging

Rnd 1: With right side of cowl facing, turn work to begin working on the bottom of foundation ch, join yarn in any ch, ch 1 , sc in each ch around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off, weave in ends on wrong side. (48 sc made)

Polyster, ( $140 \mathrm{yds} / 128 \mathrm{~m} / 2.8 \mathrm{oz} / 80 \mathrm{gms}$ ) per solid color ball), ( $105 \mathrm{yds} / 96 \mathrm{~m} / 2.1 \mathrm{oz} / 60$ grams) per multi or splash color ball):

1 ball \#44-04 America
1 ball \#38-01 White
Approx. 10 yards of each color makes one coaster.

Crochet hook size H-8 US ( 5 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Special Stitches: Half double crochet bobble stitch (hdc bobble st): [yo, insert hook in st indicated, yo, pull through st] 3 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

## ROUND COASTER

With White, ch 4 , join with sl st in $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as first hdc + ch 2), [hdc in ring, ch 2] 8 times, join with sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch of beg ch 4 . Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join America in any ch-2 sp, work hdc bobble st in same beg ch -2 sp, ch 2 , skip next st, [work hdc bobble in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, skip next st] 8 times, join with sl st in top of beg hdc bobble st. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join White in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 4 dc in same beg ch-2 sp , work 5 dc in each ch- 2 sp around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3 . Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join America in any dc, ch 1, sc in each dc around, join with sl st in top of beg sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
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Gauge: 4 rnds $=4$ inches in diameter.

GAUGE: $14 \mathrm{sc}=4$ inches. 13 rows ( 7 sc rows and 6 hdc rows) $=4$ inches. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Dishcloth

Ch 27.
Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. ( 26 sc )

Row 2: Ch 1, hdc in first sc, * skip next st, hdc in next st, hdc in previously skipped st (cross hdc made)*, rep from * to * across to last st, hdc in last st, turn. ( 12 crossed hdc plus 2 hdc made)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. (26 sc made)

Rows 4-23: Rep Rows 2 \& 3, 10 times, end of Row 23, turn and start Border.

## Border

Rnd 1: Ch 1, hdc in each st across to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), hdc in each rowend st of each row down length to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), working across bottom of foundation ch, hdc in each ch across to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), hdc in each row-end st of each row down length to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), join with a sl st to top of beg hdc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Ice Yarns "Silk Cotton" (2) Fine weight yarn, $32 \%$ Silk/ $68 \%$ Cotton) $50 \mathrm{gr} / 1.76$ oz/120 m/131 yds per ball:

1 ball - color of your choice
Crochet hook size G-6 ( 4 mm ) or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 16 dc and 11 rows $=4$ inches.

## PREMIE HAT

## Ch 4

Rnd 1: 11 dc in $4^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3. ( 12 dc )

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), 2 dc in joining st, 2 dc in each st around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st in top of first dc. (24 dc).

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in joining st, 2 dc in next st, * dc in next st, 2 dc in next st *, rep from * to * around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st in top of first dc. (36 dc)

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 3. ( 54 dc )

Rnd 1: Work 15 tr in $5^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook, join with sl st in top of beg ch 4 . ( 16 tr )

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), 2 dc in joining st, work 2 dc in each st around, skip beg ch 2, join with sl st in top of first dc. ( 32 dc )

Rnd 3: Ch 2 ( does NOT count as a stitch), dc in joining st, 2 dc in next st, * dc in next st, 2 dc in next st *, rep from * to * around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st in top of first dc. (48 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 2 (does NOT count as stitch), dc in joining st, dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, * dc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st *, rep from * to * around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st in top of first dc. ( 60 dc )

Rnds 5-13: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in each st around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st in top of beg dc. $(60 \mathrm{dc}$ )

Rnd 14: Ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in joining st, skip next st, * (sc, ch $2, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next st, skip next st *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in beg sc. ( 30 V sts). Fasten off, weave in ends.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 3. (54 dc)
Rnd 5: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in joining st, dc in each of next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, * dc in each of next $5 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st *, rep from * to * around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st to top of first dc. ( 63 dc )

Rnds 6-15: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), dc in joining st, dc in each st around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st to top of first dc. (63 dc)

Rnd 16: Ch 2 (does NOT count as a stitch), work 2 dc in joining st, dc in each remaining st around, skip beg ch 2 , join with sl st to top of first dc. ( 64 dc )

Crochet Hook size J-10 ( 6 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Gauge: Working in stitch pattern (3 sets of 3 tr shells and $2 \mathrm{dc}=4$ inches. 6 rows $=4$ inches.

Special Stitches: Front Post Treble Crochet (fptr): insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of stitch indicated, work tr around post of stitch indicated.

Note: If you would like to make a larger afghan, this stitch pattern is a multiple of 4 plus 2.

## Afghan

With Anagram, ch 98.
Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (97 sc made)

Row 2: (Right side): Ch 1, hdc in first sc, skip next sc, 3 dc in next sc, * skip next sc, dc in next sc, skip next sc, 3 dc in next sc *, rep from * to * across to last 2 sc , skip next sc, hdc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, (hdc, dc) in first sc, skip next sc, dc in next sc, *skip next sc, work 3 fptr around dc one row below next sc, skip next sc, dc in next sc *, rep from * to * across to last 2 sc, skip next sc, (dc, hdc) in last sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, hdc in first sc, skip next sc, work 3 fptr around dc one row below next sc, * skip next sc, dc in next sc, skip next sc, work 3 fptr around dc one row below next sc *, rep from * to * across to last 2 sc , skip next sc, hdc in last sc, turn.

Rows 7-106: Rep Rows 3-6, 25 times.

Rows 107-109: Repeat Rows 3-5, end of Row 109, turn, start border.

## Afghan Border

Rnd 1: With right side facing, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each sc across to next corner, ch 2 (corner made), working down length, ${ }^{* *}$ dc in row-end st of first row down length, $* 2$ dc in row-end st of next row, dc in row-end st of each of next 6 rows *, rep from * to * down length to last 3 rows, 2 dc in row-end st of next row, dc in row-end st of each of last 2 rows, ch 2 (corner made) **, dc in each ch across bottom of foundation ch, ch 2 (corner made), rep from ** to ${ }^{* *}$, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Approx. 8-10 yards (4) medium weight yarn per flower.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), 4 hdc in next ch- 1 sp , sl st in next sc, 5 hdc in next ch-1 sp, [ sl st in next sc, 5 dc in next ch- 1 sp] 5 times, $[\mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$ in next sc, 5 tr in next ch$1 \mathrm{sp}] 6$ times, sl st in last sc. Fasten off, leaving a sewing length.

## ASSEMBLY

Return to beg of Row 2, with right side facing, fold right side of first petal on top of right side of $2^{\text {nd }}$ petal, turn work upside down and wrap bottom of foundation row around bottom of petals working around to end of Row forming the Rose, sew Rose together sewing through all layers from the outside through each layer to the center, repeat around base of Rose is secure. Leave your sewing length to use for attaching to your project, then trim and weave in ends.

Finished Size: $23 / 4$ inches in diameter.

Row 1: Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, [ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch] across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 2 dc in beg sc, skip next 2 dc , fpsc in next st, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch- 1 sp, * skip next 3 dc, fpsc in next st, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-1 sp *, rep from * to * across to last 3 dc and ending turning ch, skip next 3 dc , sc in top of ending ch 3 , turn.
Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in beg sc, skip next 2 dc , fpsc in next dc, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch- 3 sp , * skip next fpsc and next 2 dc , fpsc in next dc, ch 3,3 dc in next ch-3 sp *, repeat from * to * across to last 3 sts and ending turning ch, skip next
fpsc and next 2 dc , sc in top of ending turning ch 3, turn. Repeat Row 3 for pattern until scarf measures 62" (157.5 $\mathrm{cm})$, then work Finishing Row.

## FINISHING ROW

Ch 3, 2 dc in beg sc, skip next 2 dc , fpsc in next dc, * (sc, 2 dc ) in next ch-3 sp, skip next fpsc and next $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{fpsc}$ in next dc *, repeat from * to * across ending last repeat with a sc in top of ending ch 3 . Fasten off, weave in ends.

## Fringe

Cut 128 pieces of fringe 11 " ( 28 cm ) long. With 4 strands held together, fold in half, starting in first st across end of scarf, knot fringe in first stitch. Repeat fifteen times more evenly spaced across end of scarf.

Repeat on opposite end of scarf.

To make a hat for this program, you must use the color purple, lavender, any color of purple. Hats need to be at least 50 percent of the color purple, for boy friendly hats I recommend using a darker shade of purple, for the accent color use blue, orange, green, or gray.
For girl friendly hats, you can make a solid color or add an accent color of either pink, or white. 50 Percent of each hat MUST be Purple. PLEASE ONLY USE SOFT LIGHT WEIGHT YARN SUCH AS Lion Brand Babysoft yarn.

Note: For 2 color hat work all single crochet rnds in accent color. Work Rnd 21 in main color. This keeps the hat at over $50 \%$ purple.

## Materials Needed:

Lion Brand Babysoft (3) Lightweight yarn, $60 \%$ acrylic, $\mathbf{4 0 \%}$ Nylon, ( $\mathbf{5} \mathrm{oz} / 140 \mathrm{~g} / 459 \mathrm{yds} / 420 \mathrm{~m}$ ) per skein:
For solid color hat: $\mathbf{1 1 ⁄ 2}^{1 / 2}$ oz. Main color 143
Lavender
For two color hat: 1 oz . Main color any shade of purple and $1 / 2 \mathrm{oz}$ of accent color.

Crochet Hook: 4 1/4 mm [US G-6].

GAUGE: First 6 rnds $=43 / 8$ inches in diameter. 17 sts $=4$ inches. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Hat

With main color, ch 3, sl st to form ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (first dc), 11 dc in ring, sl st to top of beg ch 3. (12 dc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1 , sc in beg st, 2 sc in next st, [sc in next $\mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st] around, join with sl st to beg sc. (18 sc made)

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in same joining st, work 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st to top og beg ch 3. ( 36 dc made)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, [sc in each next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] around, join with sl st to top og beg sc. (48 sc made)

Rnd 5: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 . ( 48 dc made)

Rnd 6: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, [sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st] around, join with sl st to beg sc. ( 56 sc made) End of Rnd 6 your work should measure $43 / 8$ inches in diameter (across the center of work side to side)

Rnd 7: Side of Hat: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3 . ( 56 dc made)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg sc. (56 sc made)

Rnds 9-14: Repeat Rnds 7 \& 8, 3 times.
Rnd 15: Rep Rnd 7. End of Rnd 15, do not join, mark each rnd.

Rnds 16-20: Rep Rnd 8

Rnd 21: Sl st in beg sc, [ch 1, sl st in next sc]
around, ending with ch 1 , sl st in same sp as starting sl st. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join color B in beg ch-2 sp, ch 3 (first dc)(2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same beg ch- 2 sp , ch 1 , * ( 3 dc , ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp of next shell, ch $1 *$, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join color A in beg ch-2 sp of beg shell, ch 3 (first dc) work 8 dc in ch- 2 sp of same beg shell, sc in ch- 1 sp between shell and next shell, $* 9$ dc in ch-2 sp of next shell, sc in ch- 1 sp between shell and next shell *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.

## Assembly

Trim pipe cleaner to length desired, wrap around center of butterfly and twist together at the center top of butterfly, turn under top of pipe cleaner to form a small curve on each side of top two ends.

Cut a 2" piece of magnetic tape and hot glue to back of your butterfly.

With color A, ch 5, sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 9 hdc in ring, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (9 hdc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, work 2 hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (18 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, work (hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. ( 27 hdc )

Rnd 4: Ch 1, work (hdc in each of next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (36 hdc)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, work (hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (54 hdc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, work (hdc in each of next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc) around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (72 hdc)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, work hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. (72 hdc)

Rnd 8: With right side facing, join Cornmeal with sl st in joining st, ch 3 (first dc) 2 dc in same st, drop lp from hook, insert hook in top of beg ch 3 and through dropped lp, pull through st (beg Popcorn made), ch 2, skip next hdc, * work Popcorn in next hdc, ch 2, skip next hdc *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg Popcorn. Fasten off. 36 Popcorns and 36 ch-2 sps.

## FRONT

Work same as Back.

## Daisy Center

Rnd 1: With Cornmeal, ch 2, 8 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join White with sl st in joining sc, (ch 8 , sl st in same joining sc) twice, $*$ sl st in next sc, (ch 8 , sl st in same sc) twice *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in same st as joining. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

## Daisy Bottom Petals

With White, ch 15 , join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 25 sc in ring, join with sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 8 , sl st in joining sc, (sl st, ch $8, \mathrm{sl}$ st) in next sc and in each sc around, join with sl st in same sc as joining. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

With right side of Potholder Front facing, sew Daisy Bottom Petals to center of Front, sew Daisy Center to center of Daisy Bottom Petals. Weave in ends.

## ASSEMBLY

Place wrong sides of Front and Back of Potholder together.

Joining Rnd: With right side of Front facing, matching Popcorns and ch-2 sp of Rnd 8 , and working through both thickness, join White with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 1 , work ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 3$, sc) in each ch-2 sp around, ch 10 , sl st in last sc made, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

Gauge: First 3 rnds $=3$ inches in diameter.

Note: Ch 3 counts as first dc of each rnd as indicated.

## STITCHES: Popcorn Stitch

(Popcorn St): 3 dc in st or sp indicated, drop loop from hook, insert hook in first dc of 3-dc group, hook dropped loop and draw through st.
Picot: Ch 3, slip st in top of last st made.

## SACHET / AIR FRESHENER

## FRONT

With Color A, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (first dc), work 15 dc in ring, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3 . (16 dc).

Rnd 2: (Ch 3, dc) in joining st, work 2 dc in each dc around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3. ( 32 dc )

Rnd 3: (Ch 3, dc) in joining st, dc in next dc, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3. $(48 \mathrm{dc})$.

Rnd 4: (Ch 3, dc) in joining st, dc in each of next 2 dc , (2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc ) around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.

## BACK

Work same as for Front.

## CENTER FLOWER

With Color B, ch 4, sl st tog to form a ring.

Rnd 1: (Popcorn st in ring, ch 3) 7 times, join with sl st in top of beg popcorn st.

Rnd 2: Sl st in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-3 sp around, join on back of work with sl st around top of popcorn st 1 rnd below (Rnd 1) at base of last sc made.

Rnd 3: Working on back of work, behind petals, * ch 6, sl st around top of next popcorn st 2 rnds below (Rnd 1) , rep from * to * around, ending with ch 6 , sl st in first ch of beg ch 6 . Fasten off.

Rnd 4: With right side of flower facing, join Color C in any ch-6 sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, tr, picot, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-6 sp around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off, leaving a long sewing length.

Sew flower to center of Front.

## ASSEMBLY

Place perfumed batting or air fresheners between wrong sides of Front and Back.

Joining Rnd: With right side of front facing, matching dcs of Rnd 4 and working through both thickness, join Color B with sl st in any dc of Rnd 4, (ch 3, sl st in next dc) around to and including last dc around, (ch 13 , sl st) in same last dc (hanging loop made), ch 3 , sl st in first dc as starting sl st. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Hot glue ribbon flower to center of flower.

Easy V-Stich Poncho

Skill Level: Easy
SIZE: Child 2-4, Child 6-8, Child 10-12
Finished Neck Circumference: $18(21,23)$ inches.

Finished Length: $19(24,28)$ inches.
Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parenthesis. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Special Stitches: V Stitch (V st): (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in stitch indicated. Shell Stitch (Shell st): (2 hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in stitch indicated.

Material Needed:
Lion Brand "Landscapes" Art. 545 (4)
Medium weight, 100\% Acrylic yarn, (3.5 $\mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{gm} / 147 \mathrm{yds} / 134 \mathrm{~m}$ ) per ball:
$4(5,6)$ skeins \# 201 Boardwalk Promenade Crochet hook Size J-10 ( 6 mm ) or size hook to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 5 V sts and $11 \mathrm{rnds}=4$ inches

## PONCHO

With Boardwalk Promenade, ch $67(73,79)$,
Ch should measure about $18(21,23)$ inches in length.

Rnd 1: Rnd 1 is worked as a row and sl st tog at the end of row, sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc in each ch across, join with sl st to beg sc, making sure not to twist first row. 66 (72, 78) sc made.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first hdc + ch 1), hdc in same joining sc, skip next 2 sc, * v st in next sc, skip next 2 sc *, repeat from * to * around, join with sl st to ch 2 of beg ch 3 . $22(24,26)$ v stitches made.

Rnd 3: Working to the right, sl st in space between last v st made and joining v st, ch 2 (first hdc) (hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc) in same sp, (Back corner shell just made), * v st in each of next $10(11,12)$ sps between v sts *, (2 hdc, ch 1,2 hdc) in next sp between $v$ sts (Front corner shell just made), rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next hdc and next ch- 1 sp , ch 2 (first hdc) (hdc, ch 1, 2 hdc ) in same ch- 1 sp , (Back corner shell just made), * v st in sp between each v st and or corner shell around to front corner shell, ( 2 hdc , ch 1, 2 hdc) in next ch- 1 sp of Front corner shell, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 2 . $11(12,13) \mathrm{v}$ stitches made between Front and back Corner Shell stitches on each side.

Rnds 5-30 (37, 44): Repeat Rnd 4 for pattern, you will work ( 2 hdc , ch 1, 2 hdc ) in each front and back corner shell only. You will work v st in all other spaces between v sts and front and back corner shell. This will increase each remaining rnd by 2 more v sts.

## Neck Edging

Rnd1: Join Boardwalk Pomenade in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ on left side of center top of back neck opening, ch 1 , sc in same ch, sc in each of next $31(34,37)$ ch, skip next 2 ch at front point, sc in each of next $30(33,36)$ ch, skip next ch, skip first ch on left side of center back, join with a sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

## Materials Needed:

Royale Size 3 Fashion Crochet Thread 1 ball choice of color

Crochet Hook size F-5 ( $3^{3 / 4} \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Gauge: 4 sc v-sts $=2$ inches
16 rows $=4$ inches

## HEADBAND

With color of choice, ch 8.
Row 1: (Sc, ch 2, sc) in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, * skip next ch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 2: (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 sp of each sc v-st across.

Rep Row 2 for pattern until you reach the length desired. Make sure you end with a even row.

Size Lengths:
Newborn: 13 inches long 3-6 months: 14 inches long 6-12 months: 16 inches long 12 months to tween: $\mathbf{1 7 . 5}$ inches long Adult: 18 inches long

These are just recommended sizes you can measure the head and use your own measurements, if you want it to fit snug.

Joining together to make band.
End of last row made, do not turn. Fold bottom of band (Row 1) and bring Row 1 up to meet last row made, turn.

Sew or crochet together through both thickness. Weave in ends.

## CHUNKY DREAMS SCARF PATTERN

## Skill Level: Beginner

Finished Size: 59 inches without fringe. 71 inches with fringe.

## Materials Needed:

AC Moore Stitch Studio " Sweet Dreams" (6) Super Bulky weight yarn. $86 \%$ Acrylic/14\% Polyester, (245 yds/224 m/280 gm/9.8 oz) per skein:

1 skein color of your choice.
Crochet Hook size N (10 mm)
Gauge: Not important with this pattern.

## SCARF

Ch 17.

Row 1: Dc in 5th ch from hook (skipped beg 4 chs counts as first dc + ch 1), * skip next 2 ch, (dc, ch 1 , dc) in next ch *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 2: Skip first dc, sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, work 3 sc in ch-1 sp of each V st across, turn.

Row 3: Skip first sc, (sl st, ch 4, dc) in next st, * skip next 2 sc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next sc*, rep from * to * across to last sc, skip last sc, turn.

Rows 4-69. Rep Rows 2 \& 3 for pattern, until a total of 69 Rows are complete. End of Row 69 fasten off.

## Fringe

Cut 30 pieces of fringe 12 inches long. With 3 pieces of yarn held together, fold fringe in half and knot to the center of each V st across each end of scarf.

Skill Level: Beginner
Finished Size: $6 \times 6$ inches
Materials Needed:
(4) Worsted weight yarn any brand.

The instructions are written for 3 different colors. You can adjust the Pattern for your own color preference

Small amount Color of Choice - Color A
Small amount Color of Choice - Color B
Small amount Color of Choice - Color C
Crochet Hook: 5mm [H-8] or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: First 2 rnds $=4$ inches in diameter.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL STITCHES: Cluster Stitch (cluster
st): work 3 tr leaving last loop of each stitch on hook, in space or stitch indicated, yo, pull through all loops on hook.

## Simple Daisy Granny Square

With Color A, ch 4 , join with sl st in $4^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 11 dc in ring, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, Color A. ( 12 dc made)

Rnd 2: Join Color B in joining st, ch 3 (counts as first tr), work 2 tr leaving the last lp of each tr on hook in same joining st, yo, pull through 3 lps on hook, ch 3 , * work 3 tr in next dc leaving the last lp of each st on hook, yo, pull through 4 lps on hook, ch 3 *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in top of beg tr cluster. Fasten off. ( 12 Cluster sts made)

Rnd 3: Join Color C in any ch-3 sp, ch 4 (first tr) ( 2 tr , ch $2,3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in same ch- 3 sp (corner made), [ 3 dc in next ch- 3 sp ] twice, $*$ ( 3 tr , ch $2,3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in next ch3 sp (corner made), [ 3 dc in next ch-3 sp] twice *, rep from $*$ to $*$ around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 4. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join Color A in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (first dc) ( 2 dc , ch 2, 3 dc ) in same corner ch- 2 sp , work 3 dc between each group of 3 sts across to next corner ch-2 sp, * ( 3 dc , ch 2, 3 dc ) in next corner ch- 2 sp , work 3 dc between each group of 3 sts across to next corner ch-2 sp *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off.

To make your square larger repeat Rnd 4 for each additional round.
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
