Easy Baby Bib

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: Newborn

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Premier Cotton Fair (2) Fine weight, 52% cotton/48% Acrylic (317 yds/290 m/3.5 oz/100 g) per ball:

1 oz. main color (color of your choice)
Several yards Accent color (color of your choice)
Crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm) or size to obtain gauge.
1 button $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in diameter.
Sewing needle
Matching sewing thread.
Yarn needle.

GAUGE:

Working in single crochet; 17 sc and 22 rows = 4 inches.

Use any size hook to obtain gauge given.

Baby Bib

With main color and G-6 (4mm) hook, ch 24.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (23 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (25 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (25 sc)

Rows 4-9: Rep Rows 2 & 3, 3 times, turn. (End of Row 9 you will have 31 sc)

Rows 10-27: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (31 sc)

Right Neck Strap

Row 28: Ch 1, sc in each of next 9 sts, sc2tog, leave remaining sts unworked, turn. (10 sc)

Row 29: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 8 sts, turn. (9 sc)

Row 30: Ch 1, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog, tuen. (8 sc)

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Row 31: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (8 sc)

Row 32: Ch 1, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog, turn. (7 sc)

Row 33: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 34-38: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (6 sc)

Row 39: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog, turn. (6 sc)

Row 40: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 41-46: Rep Rows 39 & 40, 3 times. (6 sc). End of Row 46, fasten off.

Left Neck Strap

With wrong side of bib facing, return to Row 27, join main color in 11th sc counting from left to right from edge of Row 27.

Row 28: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 9 sts, turn. (10 sc). Note: You will have 9 unworked sc in center of bib between straps.

Row 29: Ch 1, sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog, turn. (9 sc)

Row 30: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 7 sc, turn. (8 sc)

Row 31: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (8 sc)

Row 32: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sc, turn. (7 sc)

Row 33: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sc, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 34-38: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. (6 sc)

Row 39: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn. (6 sc)

Row 40: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog, turn. (6 sc)

Rows 41-46: Rep Rows 39 & 40, 3 times. (6 sc). End of Row 46, fasten off.

Bib Border

Turn Bib to right side facing, join main color in first sc of Row 46 on top right side of work in top of strap.

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Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each sc and each row-end st across top of each strap, around neck opening and around outside edge of bib, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join accent color with sl st to beg sc, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in joining st, [skip next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next st] 3 times, sc in each sc around neck opening around to top right-hand corner sc of left strap, (sc, ch 8, sl st in last sc made, sc) in corner sc, * skip next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next sc *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Finishing

Align button to top corner of strap opposite button-hole loop, sew in place.

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
