



## STITCH OF THE WEEK



### # 22 Stacked Shells Stitch

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Note:** Use hook size recommended on yarn label of the yarn you will be using.

**Stitch Multiple:** Multiple of 8 plus 4.

Example:  $8 \times 3 = 24 + 4 = 28$

To make a sample swatch, ch 28.

**Row 1** (Right side): 2 dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, (skipped 3 ch counts as first dc), skip next 3 ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch, \* skip next 3 ch, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch, skip next 3 ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 4 chs, skip next 3 ch, 3 dc in last ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), sc in first dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, \* (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 4 sts, skip next 3 sts, (sc, dc) in last dc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, 2 dc in first dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 sp, \* (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 sp \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 4 sts, skip next 3 sts, 3 dc in last dc, turn.

**Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.**
