

## STITCH OF THE WEEK



Stitch of the Week # 6 Double Wrap Stitch

**Skill Level: Advanced Beginner** 

Stitch Multiple: Multiple of 4 plus 3. Example  $4 \times 10 = 40$  plus 3 = 43

To make a sample swatch, ch 15

Row 1 (Wrong side): Skip first 3 chs (counts as first dc), dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Slip st in first dc, \* work 2-dc Cluster around post of next dc (see special stitches), sl st in next dc \*, rep from \* to \* across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), dc in each 2-dc cluster st and in each sl st across, turn.

Row 4: SI st in each of first 2 dc, work 2-dc Cluster around post of next dc, \* sI st in next dc, work 2-dc Cluster around post of next dc \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 2 dc, sI st in each of last 2 dc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, \* dc in next sl st, dc in next 2-dc cluster st \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 2 sl sts, dc in each of last 2 sl sts, turn.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Repeat Rows 3-6 for pattern.

## **USA Stitch Abbreviations used**

ch – chain dc – double crochet

rep – repeat sl st – slip stitch

yo – yarn over the hook

## **Special Stitches**

2-dc Cluster Stitch(worked around post of dc indicated), \* yo, insert hook from front to back, then back to front around post of dc indicated, yo, pull through and around post, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook \*, repeat from \* to \* once more around same st, yo, draw through all 3 lps on hook.
