**# 106 Flower Trim Edging** 

## **Skill Level: Intermediate**

This pattern you start with the first flower, then work from the repeat for each additional flower you want until you reach your desired length.

Note: Use the hook size recommended on the yarn label of the yarn you are using.

To beg, chain 6, join with a sl st in 6<sup>th</sup> ch from hook to form a ring, ch 1, First Flower: sc in ring, \* ch 4, 2 tr cluster in ring as follows: work 2 tr in ring and leave the last lp of each tr unworked, yo, and pull through all 3 lps on hook, ch 4, sc in ring (petal made) \*, rep from \* to \* 4 times more, (Flower is made and should have 5 petals), \*\* to continue to add more flowers to the edging, ch 16, sl st in 6<sup>th</sup> ch from hook (to form another ring), ch 1, sc in ring, rep from \* to \* 5 times to form flower \*\*, rep from \*\* to \*\* to desired length. Fasten off, after you make the last sc of the last petal of the last flower made.
