



#128 Baby Blanket Stitch

Skill Level: Advance Beginner

Stitch Multiple: Any number of stitches

NOTE: Best to use one size larger hook then recommended on the yarn label to make your starting chain, then drop hook size down to the recommended hook size to work pattern.

To make a sample swatch chain 10.

Row 1 (Right side): Dc into 4th ch from hook (counts as first dc cluster), dc2tog in each ch across as follows: yo, insert hook in next ch, yo, pull through ch, yo, pull through 2 lps

Row 1 cont: on hook, yo, insert hook back into same ch, yo, pull through ch, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across to within last st, sc2tog in last st as follows: insert hook in last st, yo, pull through st, insert hook in top of ending turning ch, yo, pull through ch, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in first st (counts as first dc cluster), * dc2tog in each st across as follows: yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, yo, insert hook back into same st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook * rep from * to * across, turn.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

Stitches Used:

Beg – begin (beginning)

ch - chain

rep- repeat

sc – single crochet

st - stitch

lp (lps) - loop (s)

yo- yarn over

dc – double crochet
