

#137 Alternating V Stitch

Skill Level: Beginner

Stitch Multiple of 3 plus 7 Example 3 x 3 = 9 plus 7 = 16

To make a sample swatch, chain 16.

Row 1: (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 5th ch from hook, (skipped beg 4 chs counts as 1 ch and first dc), * skip next 2 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch *, rep from * to * across to last 2 ch, skip next ch, dc in last ch, turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, dc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1(does not count as a st), hdc in first st, work (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, hdc in top of ending turning ch, turn,

Row 4: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), hdc in first st, work (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, hdc in last st, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in first st, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in first st, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-2 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, dc in last st, turn.

Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, dc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

Repeat Rows 3-8 for pattern.

Stitches Used:

beg – begin (beginning) ch – chain rep- repeat st – stitch yo- yarn over sl st – slip stitch lp- loop sc – single crochet hdc – half double crochet dc- double crochet
