



## #137 Alternating V Stitch

**Skill Level: Beginner**

Stitch Multiple of 3 plus 7  
 Example  $3 \times 3 = 9$  plus  $7 = 16$

To make a sample swatch, chain 16.

**Row 1:** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, (skipped beg 4 chs counts as 1 ch and first dc), \* skip next 2 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across to last 2 ch, skip next ch, dc in last ch, turn

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, dc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st), hdc in first st, work (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, hdc in top of ending turning ch, turn,

**Row 4:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st), hdc in first st, work (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, hdc in last st, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in first st, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in first st, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-2 sp of each V st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, dc in last st, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-1 sp of each V st across to ending turning ch, dc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

**Repeat Rows 3-8 for pattern.**

### Stitches Used:

beg – begin (beginning)  
 ch – chain  
 rep- repeat  
 st – stitch  
 yo- yarn over  
 sl st – slip stitch  
 lp- loop  
 sc – single crochet  
 hdc – half double crochet  
 dc- double crochet
