



## **#140 Split Shell Stitch**

**Skill Level: Beginner** 

Stitch Multiple of 6 plus 3

Example 6 x 5 = 30 plus 3 = 33

To make a sample swatch, chain 21.

Row 1: Skip first 5 chs (counts as 2 chs and first dc), (2 dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch, skip next 2 chs, dc in next ch, \* skip next 2 chs, (2 dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch, skip next 2 chs, dc in next ch \*, rep from \* to \* across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), skip next 2 dc, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 dc, \*dc in next dc, skip next 2 dc, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, skip next 2 dc \*, rep from \* to \* across to ending turning ch, dc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

## Repeat Row 2 for pattern to desired length, then work Finishing Row;

Finishing Row: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, skip next 2 dc and next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next ch-1 sp and next 2 dc, \*sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc and next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next ch-1 sp and next 2 dc \*, rep from \* to \* across, ending with sc in top of ending turning ch. Fasten off.

## **Stitches Used:**

beg – begin (beginning)

ch - chain

rep- repeat

st-stitch

sc- single crochet

dc- double crochet
