Stitch of the Week #150

Arruga Stitch

Skill Level: Intermediate

Stitch multiple is any EVEN number of chains.

To Make a sample swatch, chain 14.

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in each remaining ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* bpsc around post of next dc, fpsc around post of next dc \*, rep from \* to \* across to ending turning ch, sc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* fpsc around post of next dc, bpsc around post of next dc \*, rep from \* to \* across to ending turning ch, sc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each st across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* bpsc around post of next dc, fpsc around post of next dc \*, rep from \* to \* across to ending turning ch, sc in top of ending turning ch, turn.

Repeat Rows 3-6 for pattern.

## Stitched Used (USA crochet terms)

ch- chain yo- yarn sc – single crochet dc – double crochet

bpsc – back post single crochet: insert hook from back to front then from front to back around post of stitch indicated, yo, pull around post of stitch, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook.

fpsc – front post single crochet: insert hook from front to back then from back to front around post of stitch indicated, yo, pull around post of stitch, yo, oull through 2 lps on hook.
