



Harvest Stitch

Stitch of the Week #178

Skill Level: Intermediate

Stitch Multiple: 7 + 3

Example $7 \times 3 = 21$ plus 3 = 24

Make a chain using the stitch multiple.

Row 1: sc in second chain from hook (skipped ch does not count as st), sc in each ch across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next st, *skip 2 sts, [DPS, ch2, DPS] in next st, skip 2 sts, dc in each of the next 2 sts, rep from * across. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, *skip DPS, [DPS, ch 2, DPS] in next ch-2 sp, skip next DPS, dc in each of the next 2 sts, rep from * across. Turn.

Repeat Row 3 for pattern.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Stitches Used

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

yo – yarn over

sl st – sl st

rep – repeat

sp – space

ch –chain

st – stitch

lp - loop

Specialty Stitch: DPS = Double Puff Stitch. yo, insert hook into st, yo, pull through st and bring up to height of loop, [yo, insert hook into same st, yo and pull through st] four times (11 loops on hook), yo, pull through 10 loops on hook, yo, pull through rem loops on hook.

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If you would like to replace your beg chain 3 with the stacked sc to count as the first dc follow the Alternative Stacked Single crochet.

Alternative Specialty Stitch: STSC = Stacked Single Crochet. Insert hook into first stitch, yo, pull up a loop (2 loops on hook, yo and pull through both loops. Insert hook into vertical bar of stitch just made, yo and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), yo and pull through both loops.
