



Reversible Raised Half Double Crochet

Stitch of the Week #179

Skill Level: Intermediate

Stitch Multiple: any even number

Example 2, 4, 6, 8 etc.

Make a chain using the stitch multiple.

Row 1: Working in the back bump of chain (middle strand of yarn on wrong side of chain), sc in back bump of 2nd ch from hook, sc in back bump of each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, hdc in flp of next sc, sc in next sc, * hdc in flp of next sc, sc in next sc *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * hdc in flp of next corresponding st 2 rows below, pulling st up to current level of work, sc in next st going under both of the top two loops *, rep from * to * across, turn.

Repeat Row 3 for pattern.

Finishing Row (Optional): This would be the last row worked after you get to your desired length. Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten Off, weave in ends.

Stitches Used

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

flp – front loop

rep – repeat

ch- chain
