



2 skeins #214Q Cream/Mustard

Crochet Hook US K-10 1/2 (6.5 mm) or size to obtain gauge.

Gauge: Working in pattern stitch;
15 sts and 10 rows = 4 inches

**Pattern is written in English using USA
crochet terms.**

NOTE: You can make this scarf any size you wish by using the stitch multiple of 3 plus 2. Example $3 \times 10 = 30$ plus 2 = 32. If making the scarf larger you may need more yarn.

SCARF

With crochet hook size K-10 1/2 (6.5 mm) and the color Cream/Mustard, chain 26.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 2, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch*, rep from * to * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in same beg sc, *skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in next sc*, rep from * to * across to within last 3 sts, skip next 2 ch, 2 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in beg dc, * ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc *, rep from * to * across, ending by working last sc in top of ending turning ch, turn.



Butterscotch Parquet Scarf

Skill Level: Beginner

Size: 7 1/2 x 75 inches

Materials Needed:

Lion Brand Scarfie (5) Bulky weight yarn,
78% Acrylic, 22% Wool (5.3 oz/ 150 g/ 312
yd/ 285 m) per skein:

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Rows 4-155: Repeat Rows 2 & 3 for pattern, until a total of 155 rows have been completed or to desired length. End of Row 155, fasten off weave in ends.

Stitches Used:

ch-chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

yo – yarn over

rep – repeat

st – stitch

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
